**T**he City of O'Fallon in partnership with the Mid-East Area Agency on Aging (MEAAA) is providing the Senior Transportation and Rides (STAR) Program.

The goal of the activity is to provide transportation for necessary medical services to a limited number of eligible O'Fallon residents.



## **How it works**

- Transportation is provided to destinations of medical services within St. Louis and St. Charles counties, including hospitals, doctors' offices and other medical facilities.
- Individual volunteers drive seniors to and from their destinations.

- Passengers are responsible for the scheduling and canceling their own trips with the Transportation Coordinator.
- Reservations will be taken on a first-come, first served basis and must be made at least 3 days in advance.
- Except in an emergency, a cancellation must be made at least 24 hours in advance.
- MEAAA will provide an initial assessment of the applicant to determine needs that may be met through other MEAAA programs.

## **Eligibility**

In order to be considered for the Program, the applicant must:

- Be 62-years-old or older
- Lack access to a vehicle or be unable to drive
- Be a U.S. citizen or legal alien
- Reside within the corporate city limits of O'Fallon

## **How to apply**

- Applications for the program are available through MEAAA.
- MEAAA will conduct an in-home visit to determine the required mode of transportation and to provide an assessment of the applicant.
