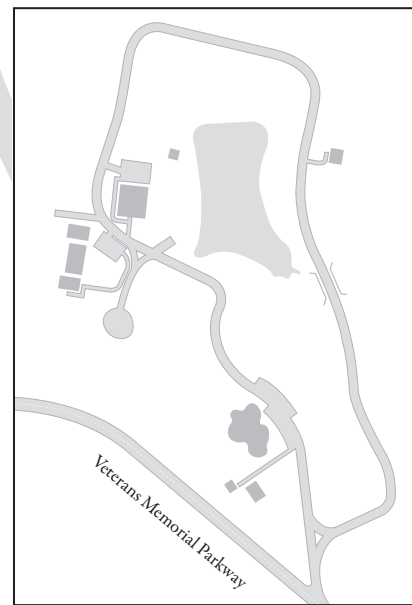


# 4th Annual Founders' Day • Fort Zumwalt Park • O'Fallon, Missouri
