

# 2018 Camp Information

Camp Paperwork will be available **February 15, 2018**. All paperwork will be posted online for parents to print in advanced and fill out. The forms must be printed out and completely filled out by hand. We will not accept any copies of forms. Forms that have not been filled out by hand or have missing or illegible information will not be accepted until corrections are made. Please be aware, that due to space limitations, submitting a completed form does not guarantee a spot in camp. To get the weeks you want, register early. No form will be accepted until the first day of registration.

Registration for residents and members opens at 7 a.m. on Saturday, March 10, at the Renaud Spirit Center.

Non-resident registration opens at 8 a.m. on Monday, March 26.

Field trip costs are included in the fees! Our qualified counselors will coordinate activities and supervise campers. Campers must bring sack lunches, a snack and drinks daily; no refrigeration is available for food.

Registration is made on a first-come, first-served basis with a limited number of spots for each session. Please note, camp themes and field trips are subject to change without notice. Campers must be registered at least two weeks in advance, and sessions must be paid in full at that time. Registration closes when the session is full, or two weeks before camp starts, whichever comes first. When you register, we need your email address so we can send weekly updates about camp.
